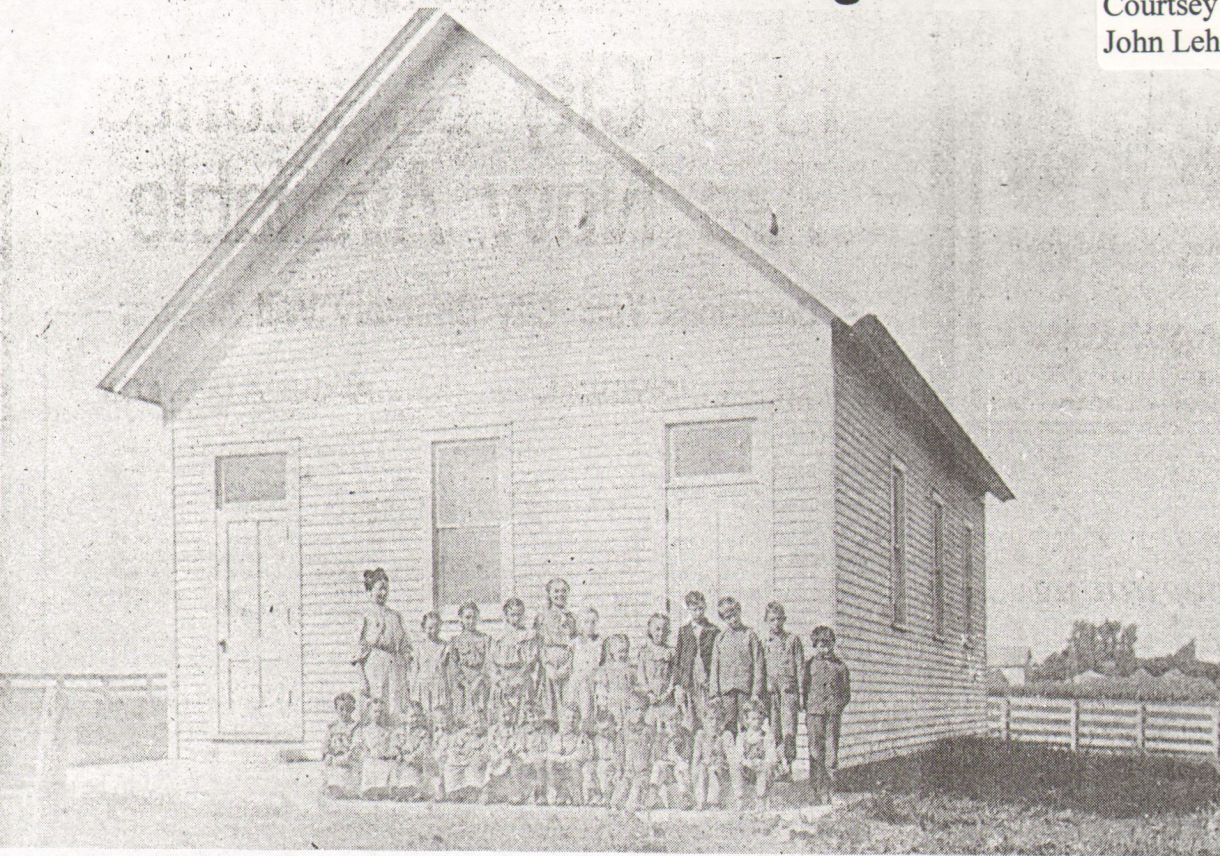


# "The Past Is Prologue"
