To the Teacher:

You should receive two blanks from the County Superintendent. Both of these should be filled in. One should be sent to the County Superintendent as soon as the school is closed and the other should be filed with your district clerk together with the register and other records. Call the attention of the District Clerk to items 10, 11 and 12. These and the one given below on this page are the only ones he will use from your report in making his report to the County Superintendent.

If more than one teacher taught in a one-room school during the year, the report for the year must be made by the teacher employed during the last term of school. The data can be obtained from the register.

In case the school has more than one department, one report to the County Superintendent must be made for the whole school by the principal. Copies of this blank may, however, be distributed by the principal to his teachers if he desires, to facilitate the compilation.

If you have a high school, think of it as one department.

Be sure your answers are correct. Especially be careful in the attendance tabulations. Be sure every child is properly credited in your report.

Begin early to compile the information required in making this report in order that you may be able to have the report completed when your school closes.

*To get No. 15 add the number of days' attendance in your school of all pupils enrolled during the year.

1. Date of opening school Sept. 9, 1935, closing June 4, 1936.
Number of days school has been maintained during the year, including legal holidays and days teacher has attended institute or convention and also including days the school has been closed because of contagious diseases, provided the teacher has been paid for the time.
